They have been looking for a way to expand their space, as they have three services each Sunday to accommodate the congregation. The only hitch with the donation is that the congregation that is closing down has a \$70,000.00 debt that needs to be paid by December 20<sup>th</sup>. Sigfredo asked us to please present this need before you. Sunday the congregation in Cuenca pledged \$25,000.00. One believer wrote to us that he is selling his TV, fridge, and other belongings to get together the \$1000.00 that he has promised. That type of sacrifice isn't seen often here in the USA.*

*Please ask the Lord if He would have you help this church in this time of need. The building is really a great bargain, with seating for 400 people and various other facilities. The church is a growing congregation. In the previous location other Christian workers will raise up a new congregation.*

We received \$100.00 toward the bicycles for the pastors in India.
